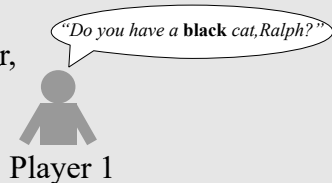


# Color-specific Go Fish™ – Ages 5+, 2-5 players

Same basic rules as Classic Go Fish, with an important difference....




When asking, (rule #2), players must include a color, e.g. “Do you have a (black) cat?”



Each item has 4 different color versions  
2 in picture form

and 2 in written form. **pen pen**

The specific colors for each item are displayed in the plus-shaped icon in the upper-right corner of each card.

Any 2 colors of an item form a pair  
picture-picture,    
written form-written form, **pen pen**  
or picture-written form,  **pen**  
and **must be laid face up on table.**

These become a reference for future questions for all players.

This color-specific version may initially seem a more difficult version than Classic Go Fish, and it is indeed more complex- however it is actually easier for the new reader to first narrow the possible cards by color when they are asked a question, and/or with the help of the mini Assist Sheet which is included.

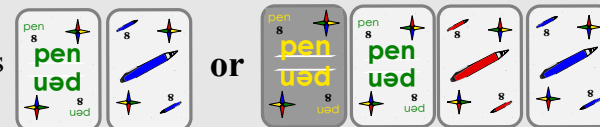
The assist sheet also helps new readers to locate a card, and allows them to play on thier own without assistance from other players.

# Concentration- Ages 5+ 2-6 players

1. Choose a desired set of cards:

picture and written-word cards  
(one of each or two of each)



picture cards only



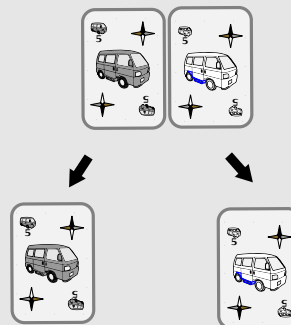
or written-word cards only



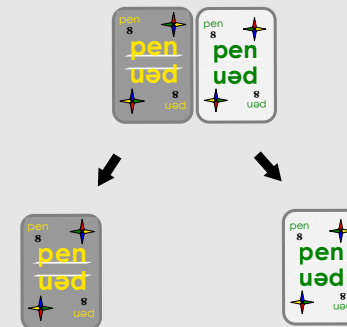
2. Separate into same-type groups,

with one (or two) card(s) of each item in each group,  
depending on the desired number of cards to be used.

written-word cards only



picture and written-word cards  
(one of each )

picture and written-word cards  
(two of each )
